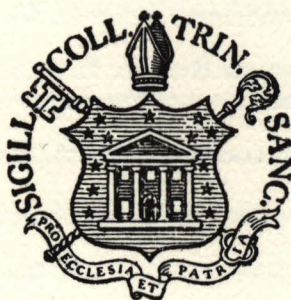

This alumnus of the highest distinction first devoted his energies and talents to teaching science and mathematics in the schools of Eastern America. JOHN VERNON BUTLER
