KINGMAN BREWSTER, JR.

Doctor of Laws, Honoris Causa

Plato filias Necessitatis memorat, Lachesin praeterita, Clotho praesentia, Atropon futura canentis. Curatoribus autem Universitatis Yalensis nuper anquirentibus quem universitati praeferent, Lachesis huius res gestas: Yalensem, post apud Harvardianos Legum professorem, gubernatorum rei publicae consiliarium, librorum de legibus scriptorem; Clotho praesentia: ut omnem rem Yalensem rebus gerundis praefectus tuitus sit; Atropos studium artium liberalium scientiarumque innatum cecinere. Ad te, Praeses Honorande, novum Universitatis Yalensis praesidem duco, Kingman Kingmanni filium Brewster.

Plato speaks of the Daughters of Necessity: Lachesis singing of the past, Clotho of the present, Atropos of the future.
