Una presented the financial report, see enclosed copy, and please note that projected figures cover a six week period. The question of inflationary effects on staff wages was raised. It was decided that staff should take paid vacations and should reevaluate their ceiling income set quite some time ago. This will be further discussed at the next meeting.

We had a discussion on fundraising and set out the following program for the Fall. In September we will begin a re-subscription drive for the newsletter and do a sample mailing of the mailing list given to us by MAI. Coming up in Christmaswe will do another mailing to our contributors list, last years mailing realized \$2,471.10 net. Paul and Louis agreed to try to get the second portion of the Fentagon Papers list and have Dan Blasberg sign a letter soliciting pledges to Resist to be sent out with the copy of the newsletter which will contain an atticle on the pledge system written by Bob Zevin. The stricle will encourage people on our newsletter list to become part of our pledge system. Hank has already decided to write a number of people whom he knows personally urging them to become pledges. We figured that most people Know at least half a dozen people who could be approached. We are sending you a copy of Hank's letter: if you would like to use it and contact people you can either do it through the office or handle it yourself. However, we would like you to send us the names of the people you are contact so we can make sure they are not already on our pledge list. We are all in agreement that our pledges are our most reliable funding base and that we should try to expand this base or at least keep it from declining. Please let us have your lists if you want us to send out the letters please include any personal notes etc. that you want included with the letter and if you want to write your own letter thats fine. But Please Co-operate in some way or other. Incidentally we do have an order for new stationary so let us know how much you need and we'll send it along as soon as it is delivered.
