Minutes for the October 6th meeting

People looked at the financial report and discussed reasons for our crisis. We seemed to come up with the combination of overspending, overprojecting and a decrease in our income. The summer slump seems to be continuing into the fall. Encumbrances for next month are high because of old bills for instance \$152 for the mailing house includes the last two months expenses. The Coplan mailing will go out in late October. People felt an all out effort should be made to recruit funds and had the following suggestions.

Anyone who knows large contributors personally could write or call them and ask for a contribution. If people want to look through the contributors files for this purpose let us know when you are coming in.

Hank suggested that a mailing go out to the radical caucuses of the professional associations in an attempt to increase our pledge base. Please respond to this suggestion because people want more of a sense of whether this is advisable or not. The newsletter goes to the printer on the 15th so get in touch with us this week on it.

To cut down on expenses we decided to stuff the October newsletter ourselves. All people able to help are encouraged to come to the office on Sunday the 27th around noon. People also wanted to discuss the financial situation further at that time.

We made no definite decision about a November meeting and will probable discuss that at the stuffing meeting on the 27th.
