Minutes for Resist Meeting - September 7, 1975

Financial Report: submitted. August was a low income month. Interns will be reminded of their loan they owe and asked about the use of their mailing list. Plans to go ahead with the contributors mailing was decided. Paul is in charge of getting the letter ready. The office will work on getting the addresses ready and it should go out as soon as possible.

Office Report: Newsletter - The August newsletter will be laid out this week. Hank and Larry worked on it. Articles will be on Korea by Boone Schirmer, the Santa FE Community Press, and an article on organizing the unemployed from the United UDEP Workers in New York. The September newsletter will be worked on by Eileen and Wayne. Articles will be on the Middle East by Noam, Unemployment by Frank, and a follow up on Senate Bill 1 researched by Hilda, an article from a Chicano project in the Southwest solicited by Ken. October's newsletter has planned a piece by Hank on Fascism, and an article on Grand Juries by Paul. Staff - Eileen has returned from vacation. Larry has taken another job. People discussed possibilities for the position and action will be taken to fill the vacancy. Work is somewhat behind in the office and non-staff should make an extra push to come in and help out. Response to the June newsletter has been overwhelming, complimenting the article on Senate Bill #1. People want to know what we are doing about it, and what can be done in general to meet this fascist move. A follow up is necessary. Grand Juries - the names of those contacted last month about the Scott press statement opposing grand juries jury abuse were submitted to the people at the Center for Constitutional Rights, we received no further word on the matter.

Resist's Future: Written replies to the draft call were not submitted to Wayne which made his job an easy one. The strengths and weaknesses of Resist were discussed and the call will be worked on again at the next meeting. Frank, Paul and Hank all agreed to write drafts to work with.
