TRINITY COLLEGE.

A PETITION for the charter of Washington College was presented to the Legislature of Connecticut, May 13, 1823. The charter having been obtained, and the requisite funds for organizing the Institution having been procured, a site was purchased in the city of Hartford, and the buildings were begun in June, 1824. In September of that year the first students were gathered, and in August, 1827, the first class graduated. In 1845, upon a memorial from the Trustees, the Legislature changed the name of the College to that which it now bears. A subsequent amendment of the charter in 1849, revised in 1857, declared the Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Connecticut, for the time being, *ex officio*, Chancellor of the College, and President of the Board of Trustees. In 1857, the charter was again amended to admit the election of Trustees residing in other states.

In 1845, the Trustees organized the House of Convocation and the Board of Fellows. In 1859, under the same authority, the Board of Visitors was established.

The Senate, according to the Statutes, consists of the Chancellor and Visitors, the Trustees or Corporation, the President and Faculty, and all graduated members of the College, the graduates being organized as the House of Convocation. The Board of Fellows consists of six Fellows elected by the Corporation, and of six Junior Fellows, ap-

proved by the Corporation on nomination of the House of Convocation.

The Rt. Rev. T. C. Brownell, D. D., LL. D., first President of the College, retired from that office in 1831. In 1849, he became the first Chancellor of the College. The second President was the Rev. N. S. Wheaton, D. D., who held his office till 1837. A constant friend of the Institution during his life, he became its largest benefactor by his bequests in 1862. The Rev. S. Totten, D. D., LL. D., was President from 1837 to 1848. To him succeeded the Rev. (now Rt. Rev.) John Williams, D. D., an Alumnus and Tutor of the College, and after his retirement from the presidency in 1853, he was appointed Vice-Chancellor. The Rev. D. R. Goodwin, D. D., was President from 1853 to 1860.

Among the past Professors were the late Rt. Rev. G. W. Doane, D. D., LL. D., Professor of Rhetoric and Oratory from 1824 to 1828; Rt. Rev. Horatio Potter, D. D., LL. D., Professor of Mathematics and Natural Philosophy from 1828 to 1833, now one of the Visitors; the late George Sumner, M. D., Professor of Natural History from 1824 to 1855; the late J. Smyth Rogers, M. D., Professor of Chemistry and Natural Science from 1828 to 1839; Duncan L. Stewart, LL. D., Professor in several departments from 1833 to 1856; and the Rev. A. Jackson, D. D., an Alumnus of the College, Tutor and Professor in several departments from 1837 to 1858.

Four Professorships are either partly or wholly endowed, under the names of Seabury, Hobart, Brownell, and Scovill. An endowment for a fifth, to be called the Massachusetts Professorship, has been begun. Four Library Funds, the Elton, the Sheffield, the Peters, and the Burgess, and one Prize Fund, the Tuttle, have been established. The Scholarships are enumerated on another page.

The College buildings are three in number. Seabury Hall, so named from the first Bishop of Connecticut, contains the Chapel, Library, Cabinet, and other public rooms. The Library consists of about 7,000 volumes. Jarvis and Brownell Halls, named from the second and third Bishops of the same Diocese, contain recitation and lodging rooms, with two

Professors' residences. The grounds comprise about fourteen acres and border on the City Park.

Trinity College is the only College of the Church in New England and Eastern New York. Nearly two hundred of her graduates have entered the ministry, a number amounting to almost one-tenth of the present number of Clergy in the Protestant Episcopal Church of the United States. To the Church, to all Christian bodies, to the part of the country in which it is situated, and to the whole country, the College offers a course of education, based upon religious principles, and intended to train its students to be good scholars, good citizens, and good men.

SCHOLARSHIPS.

THE fee for tuition (\$50 per annum) is remitted to all communicants in the Protestant Episcopal Church who are unable to pay it. This is effected chiefly through the Scholarships herein enumerated.

SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE DIOCESE OF CONNECTICUT.

In 1844 and 1845, the sum requisite for the endowment of these Scholarships was subscribed in the Diocese of Connecticut. They are for the benefit of young men in indigent circumstances, communicants of the Protestant Episcopal Church. The right of nomination is vested in the founders, and each Scholarship entitles to free tuition. They are as follows:

SCOVILL SCHOLARSHIP, founded by J. M. L. Scovill, Esq., of Waterbury.

ELTON SCHOLARSHIP, founded by John P. Elton, Esq., of Waterbury.

ST. JOHN'S, WATERBURY, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by parishioners of St. John's Church, Waterbury.

TRINITY CHURCH, NEW HAVEN, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Parishioners of Trinity Church, New Haven.

ST. PAUL'S, NEW HAVEN, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Parishioners of St. Paul's Church, New Haven.

LAKE SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Benjamin T. Lake, Esq., of Bethlem.

HALLAM SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Rev. Robert A. Hallam, of New London.

ST. JAMES', NEW LONDON, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Parishioners of St. James' Church, New London.

SHELTON AND SANFORD SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Shelton and Sanford families, of Derby.

MORGAN SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Rev. John Morgan, of Stratford.

FOWLER SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Fowler family, of Northford.

CORNELL SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Samuel G. Cornell, Esq., of Greenwich.

ST. PAUL'S, NORWALK, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Parishioners of St. Paul's Church, Norwalk.

TRINITY CHURCH, PORTLAND, SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Parishioners of Trinity Church, Portland.

SHERMAN SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Sherman family, of Brookfield.

BURR SCHOLARSHIP, founded by Mrs. Sarah Burr, of Hartford.

SIX OTHER SCHOLARSHIPS were endowed in the same manner by sundry subscriptions, and the nomination to these is vested in the Corporation.

SCHOLARSHIP OF CHRIST CHURCH, HARTFORD.

This was founded in 1839, by J. Smyth Rogers, M. D., Professor of Chemistry, who relinquished a claim against the College, on condition that the interest should be annually paid in support of such a Scholarship. In 1845, in consideration of the subscription from the Parish for the erection of Brownell Hall, the endowment was increased. The right of nomination is vested in the Rector of Christ Church.

SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP SOCIETY.

The Church Scholarship Society of the Diocese of Connecticut, aids a number of students with loans, not exceeding \$100 *per annum*, which are granted only to persons in

necessitous circumstances, preparing for Holy Orders, and sustaining a correct deportment as communicants. Applicants must be furnished with a testimonial of such qualifications, signed by a clergyman to whom they are personally known. The President of the College is President of the Executive Board of the Church Scholarship Society.

SCHOLARSHIP OF ST. PAUL'S CHURCH, TROY, N. Y.

This was founded in 1830, by members of the Parish whose name it bears. It is "for the benefit of pious and indigent young men, studying with a view to the ministry in the Protestant Episcopal Church." The right of nomination is in the Rector, Wardens and Vestry of St. Paul's Church, Troy.

HEARTT SCHOLARSHIP.

This was founded in 1830, and endowed by Philip Heartt, Esq., of Troy. It has the same object with the preceding Scholarship. The right of nomination was vested in Mr. Heartt during his lifetime; and afterwards, in the Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Connecticut; and during any vacancy in the episcopate, devolves on the presiding officer of the College.

SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE SOCIETY FOR PROMOTING RELIGION AND LEARNING IN NEW YORK.

These are two in number, and were founded in 1843, under an arrangement with the Society. They entitle the students by whom they are held to free tuition. The right of nomination is in the Society; and in return the College have the right to nominate, after free competition, to a Scholarship in the General Theological Seminary of the Protestant Episcopal Church.

SCHOLARSHIPS OF TRINITY CHURCH, NEW YORK.

These are five in number, and were founded in 1834, in consideration of the sum of \$5,000, granted by the Vestry of Trinity Church, New York, towards the endowment of the

Hobart Professorship. The students by whom they are held are exempt from all charges "for tuition, room rent, fuel for recitation-rooms, or other general objects." The right of nomination is in the Rector, Wardens, and Vestry of Trinity Church, or their assigns, or any person by them authorized.

THOMAS BACKUS SCHOLARSHIP.

This was founded in 1837, by the Rev. Stephen Jewett, M. A., to be held "by some beneficiary designing to enter the ministry of the Protestant Episcopal Church," and yields one hundred dollars annually, for which the beneficiary is to give his obligation, payable, with interest, four years after he leaves the College.
