## *Lise Waxer*

May 30, 1965- August 13, 2002



With deepest sorrow, the members of the Music Department announce the death of our colleague Lise Waxer, on August 13, 2002. A Canadian-born ethnomusicologist, she conducted extensive ethnographic and historical research on salsa music and its Cuban roots. Her studies included fieldwork in Canada, Colombia, Cuba, and Venezuela. She wrote extensively about salsa and its international diffusion, and also performed in salsa and Latin jazz groups. Waxer completed doctoral studies at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, and had finished working on a book manuscript based on her dissertation field research on salsa in Cali, Colombia, to be published by Wesleyan University Press. She also edited a collection of scholarly essays on salsa in global perspective, *Situation Salsa: Global Markets and Local Meaning in Latin Popular Music*, (Routledge, 2002). Her contributions to Trinity College, the city of Hartford, and the international scholarly community, as well as her tireless activities as a musician, teacher, mentor, advisor, colleague and friend are her abiding legacy.

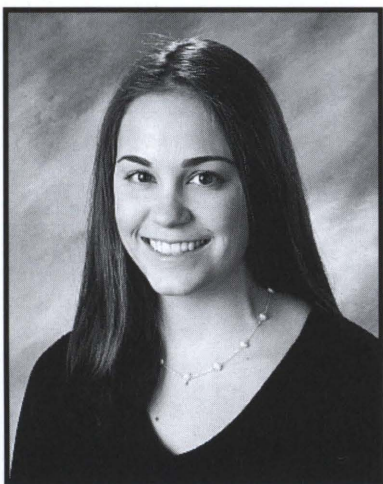

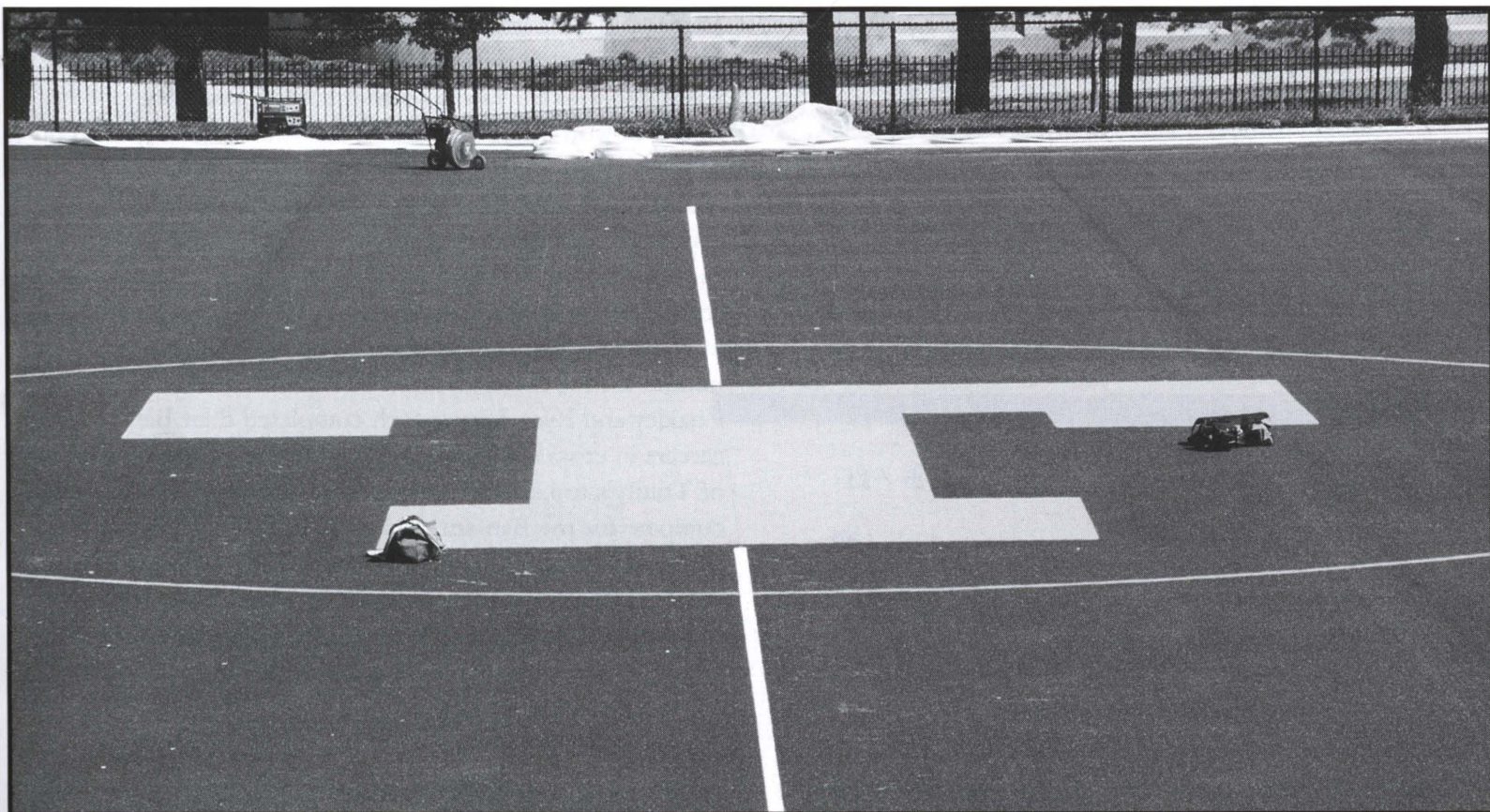


The Trinity College football team defeated Wesleyan, 26-10, on Nov. 9 in its season finale. Senior quarterback Greg Ward threw for 183 yards and two touchdowns at Wesleyan, which was ranked No. 8 in New England entering the game, to give the Bantams their sixth consecutive victory and a share of the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC) Championship title. Senior free safety Gavin O'Reilly forced and returned a fumble 58 yards for a Bantam touchdown and senior captain running back Brian Fabrizio paced the Trinity running game with 55 yards on 18 carries.

Trinity, coached by Chuck Priore, tied Williams for first place in the NESCAC with a 7-1 record. The Bantams share the top record in the conference for the first time since 1996, when they also shared the top spot with Williams at 7-1. Trinity led the league in total defense (220 yds. allowed per game), rushing defense (69.0 yds. allowed per game), and scoring defense (13.8 points allowed per game). The Bantams were also third in the NESCAC in both rushing offense with 182 yards per game on the ground and pass efficiency with a rating of 118.7, and fourth in the conference in scoring offense at 23.5 ppg.

The Bantams finished as the No. 6-ranked team in the final New England Division III Poll. Fifteen seniors finished their Trinity football career against Wesleyan, including Fabrizio at running back, Justin Moore at center, David Midura at linebacker, and David Rooney at nose tackle. Fabrizio and Moore were vital parts of the Bantam offense, as Fabrizio started for four years and Moore for the last three. Fabrizio ran the ball 117 times for 512 yards (4.4 yds. per carry) and five touchdowns this fall, along with two catches out of the backfield for 51 yards, one kickoff return for 10 yards, and six punt returns for 41 yards. Fabrizio shared the ball-carrying load with Pierandri, who led the Bantams with 146 carries for 535 yards and five touchdowns and caught eight balls for 55 yards.

For his career, Fabrizio rushed the ball 507 times for 2,145 yards (5th all-time) for 4.32 yards per carry and 18 touchdowns, caught 43 passes (6th all-time among running backs) for 550 yards (12.8 yds. per rec.) and three scores, and totaled 107 yards on 11 kick returns for a total of 2,802 all-purpose yards. Moore started all eight games at center, helping Trinity rush for 1,474 yards (4.2 yds. per carry) and anchored an offensive line that yielded just four sacks. He also was a three-year starter at center. Senior guard Dan Smith also started all eight games on the Trinity offensive line and senior guard Tom Good provided quality depth at various positions. For his career, Midura had 153 tackles (73 solo), 13 tackles for loss, eight pass breakups, two fumble recoveries, and three sacks, while Tubbs totaled 93 tackles (55 solo), 13 tackles for loss, and 3.5 sacks. Rooney, who finished his Bantam career along with defensive lineman Dan Jacobs at Wesleyan, was the top player on the Bantam defensive line that held opponents to 69 rushing yards this season often taking up two blockers against both the pass and the run. Second team all-NESCAC last fall, Rooney finished with 26 tackles (14 solo), five tackles for loss, three sacks, and a fumble recovery in eight starts at nose tackle this fall. Rooney totaled 80 tackles (42 solo), 14 tackles for losses, three fumble recoveries, and 7.5 sacks, while Jacobs recorded 14 tackles and a sack in his career.

The Trinity men, coached by George Sutor, finished the season as the No. 5 Cross Country Team team in New England. The men's squad qualified two runners for its National Championships at St. Olaf, and senior co-captain Ryan Bak won the race to earn the NCAA men's individual title. Bak won the 8,000-meter race with a course-record time of 25:01. Bak broke the course record at St. Olaf by 20 seconds and finished ahead of the second place runner by seven full seconds to capture the title and earned All-American honors for the second straight season. Classmate and fellow Trinity senior co-captain Jim Emord finished the race in 25:31 to finish 13th overall and receive All-American honors for the second year in a row as well. Seniors Steven Coakley and Ryan Lerner each completed their Bantams careers in cross country this fall as well. Both were members of Trinity's top seven throughout their careers and also compete for the Bantam track and field squads. Lerner recorded his season-best time in the NCAA Division III New England Championships at 26:19 and Coakley ran a season-best time of 26:42 in the New England Open Championships. Lerner has a career-best time of 25:50 and Coakley has a career-best time of 26:23.

Trinity Field Hockey coached by Anne Parmenter, finished the season in ninth place in the NESCAC with a 2-7 league record. The Trinity College baseball team, which finished the 2003 regular season as the first-place team in the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC) East Division, played NESCAC West runner-up Williams on the opening day of the NESCAC Championship Tournament. The Bantams, coached by Bill Decker, posted a 19-8 overall record and a 9-3 mark in the NESCAC East. Trinity is currently ranked No. 2 in New England and No. 22 in the nation, according to the latest American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA)/ *Collegiate Baseball* polls. Trinity boasts arguably the top pitcher in the NESCAC this spring, as junior right-hander Kevin Tidmarsh is 7-0 with 48 strikeouts and a 2.16 ERA in 50 innings. Sophomore righties Chris Rodday, Mark Tremblay, and Joe Westcott have combined for an 8-3 record with 70 strikeouts in 84.2 innings, while senior Craig Tredenick has been consistent in the late innings with two saves and 19 strikeouts. The Trinity offense batted a league-best .363 (11th in nation) and has scored 10.4 runs per game (3rd in nation) as a unit during the regular season, blasting more than twice as many homeruns (49) as any other team in the league. Senior co-captain infielder Kurt Piantek is batting .537 (1st in NESCAC, 2nd in nation) with a team-high 51 hits, 38 runs, seven doubles, 11 home runs, and 50 RBI, while classmate Rob Dolliver has a .412 average (5th in NESCAC) with 40 hits, 38 RBI, and nine homers, and sophomore Jeff Natale is hitting .463 with a team-high 11 doubles, 36 runs, 38 hits, nine homers, and 29 RBI. Senior co-captain Kurt Piantek went 5-for-8 with three home runs, four runs, and six RBI, breaking his own season records for home runs and runs batted in, leading the visiting Trinity College Bantams to a 11/5-6/3 sweep of the Amherst College Lord Jeffs in the New England Small College Athletic Conference (NESCAC) Baseball Championship Finals. Trinity wins the league tournament for the first time and earns its fourth bid to the NCAA Division III Championship Tournament.

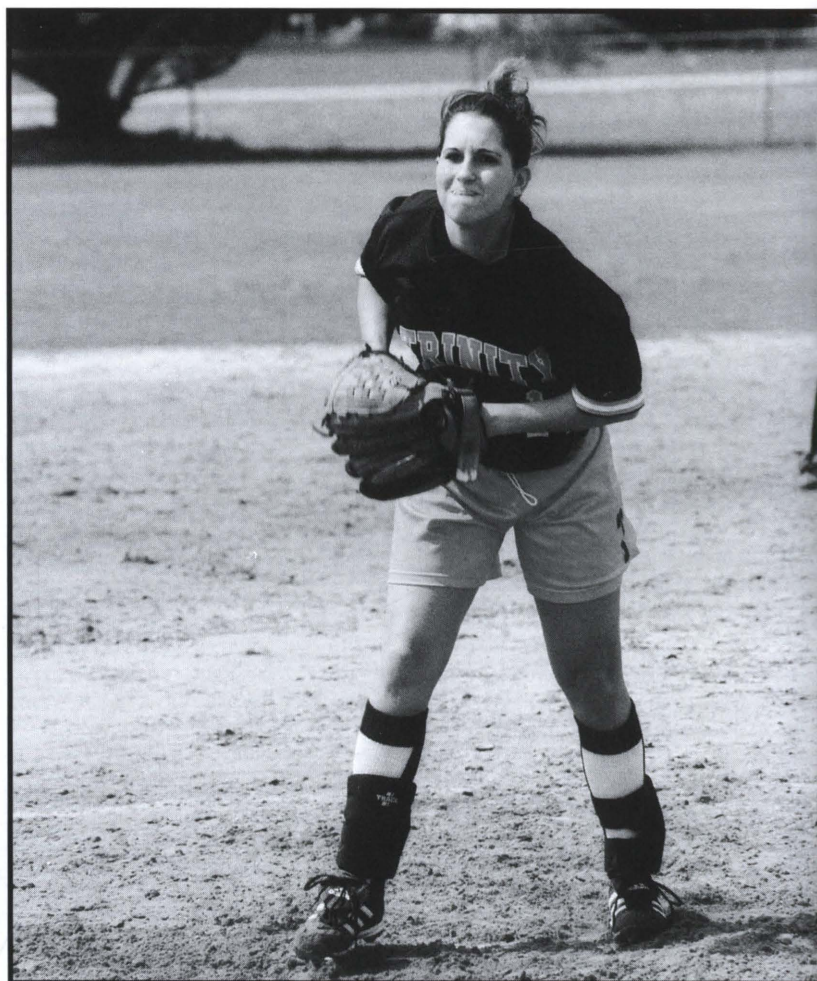

Moshier surrendered an unearned run in the top of the first inning of the first game, and just one more run the rest of the way in a 4-2 Bantam triumph. After Wesleyan tied the game at 2-2 in the fifth inning, Trinity went back ahead on a single by Heath, and RBI triple by senior Susan Kelly, and an RBI single by freshman Alexandra Costello. Senior co-captain SS Laura Heath is a four-year starter and a two-time all-league selection, while senior co-captain Maureen Heneghan has started at 1B for four years. Heath batted .341 with seven doubles and 13 RBI, while Heneghan hit a team-high .347 with 25 runs and 20 steals in 2001. The two veterans, along with sophomore 3B Marion-Anna Protano, give the Bantams three infielders who are dependable with the glove and dangerous with the bat.

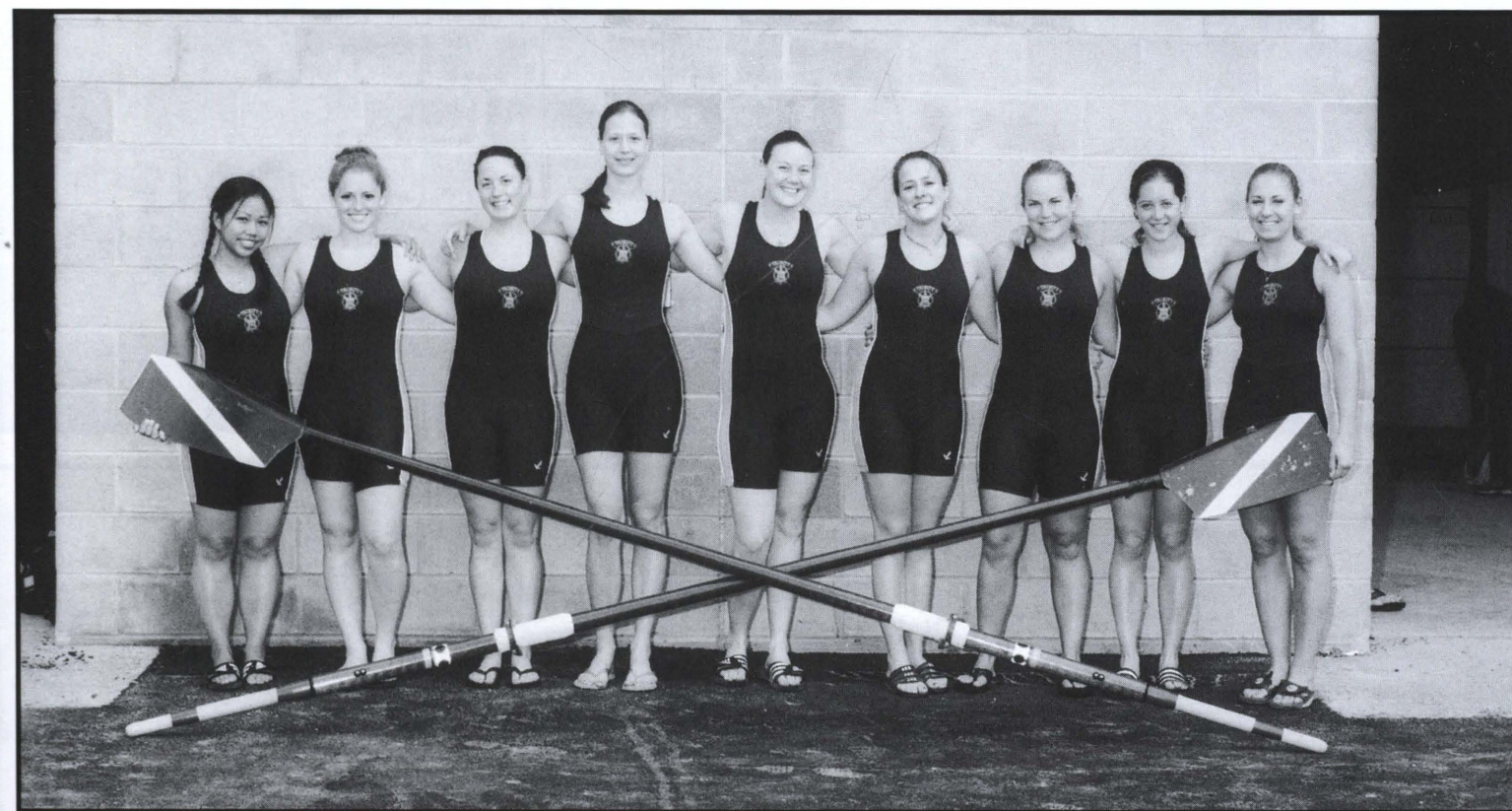
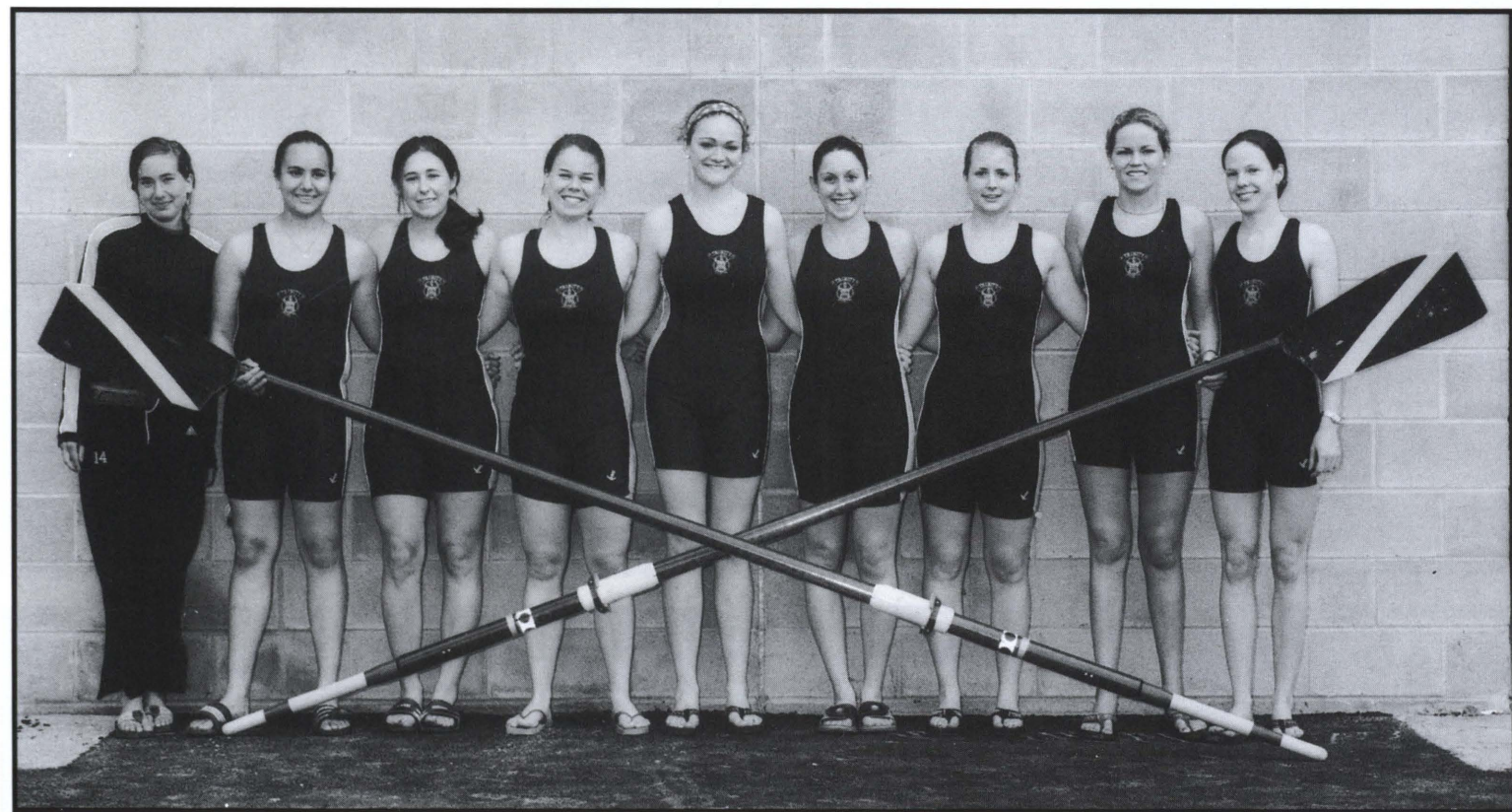


# Women's Crew
