# LIBRARIAN'S REPORT.

*Trinity College,*

*Hartford, Connecticut*

*To the Trustees of Trinity College:*

In accordance with Section Three of Article Fifteen of the Statutes of the College, I submit herewith the report of the Librarian for the year ending July 30, 1924.

As in other years, the Library has been kept open fifty-four hours per week, and the usual statistics in regard to attendance are given:

These figures indicate that there has been no striking change in the degree to which the Library has been used by the students. Probably there is no reason to expect any so long as the number of students does not vary greatly and so long as methods of teaching do not change radically.

### INCREASE OF THE LIBRARY

During the year, there have been added to the Library 3275 volumes and 1702 pamphlets. Of these 764 volumes were purchased, and all the pamphlets and other items presented. Included among the purchases are 99 volumes of unbound periodicals, and 21 volumes paid for from the Appropriation of the Departments of Civil Engineering and Chemistry. Of the volumes added to the Library, 1614 are bound and 661 unbound. It should be added that part of the periodicals entered as unbound have already been bound or will be bound soon.

The generous appropriation from the income of the Morgan Fund has been most helpful, enabling us to purchase books urgently needed that otherwise could not have been secured. Practically every Department has been benefitted, but this year the Department of German has needed particular attention. Without this appropriation under present conditions, the Library would be hopelessly handicapped in the effort to secure the books most needed in the work of instruction, and it is earnestly hoped it can be continued till the income from our Library Funds can be substantially increased.

Some of the more important purchases of the year may here be mentioned: German authors including Grillparzer, Gottfried Keller, Morike, Ludwig, Holderlin, Wagner, Uhland, Hebel, Lenau, and Tieck; La France's ed. of Rabelais; Loti, *Oeuvres*; Honotaux's *Histoire de la France Contemporaines*; Lavissee and Rambaud's *Histoire general de la France du IV<sup>e</sup> siecle a nos jours*; Heath's *History of Greek Mathematics*; Bemis' *Jay's Treaty*, Bret Harte-works; Meredith-works; *Mythology of all Races*; the first twenty volumes of the *Publications of the Modern Language Association of America*—to complete our file; Thorpe's *Dictionary of Applied Chemistry*; Mellor's *Comprehensive Treatise on Inorganic and Theoretical Chemistry*; and Beilstein's *Handbuch der organische Chemie*.

### GIFTS

Appendix II gives the names of donors of the year; to these should be added the names of donors of current preiodicals given

at the beginning of Appendix I. We are again indebted to Mrs. Henry Ferguson and to members of the Faculty for their constant remembrance of the Library.

Some of the gifts call for particular mention:

From General Lucius B. Barbour, of Hartford, we received a gift of some 130 volumes in memory of his father, the late General Lucius A. Barbour, a distinguished citizen of Hartford. The gift includes a long "run" of Harper's Magazine, handsomely bound, completing our file; the Journal of American History, and the Magazine of American History—both handsomely bound. From the Rev. William A. Beardsley, D.D., of the Class of 1887, we received 25 bound volumes of early Connecticut newspapers. From Newton C. Brainard, a Trustee of the College, we received a complete set of the "Journal of Egyptian Archaeology", for the most part substantially bound. Under the will of the late Rev. George McClellan Fiske, D.D., of the Class of 1870, we received 1350 volumes. Of these 553 have already been catalogued, and make a valuable addition to the resources of the Library. From the Executors of the estate of the late Rev. Dr. Francis Goodwin, long a trustee and always a generous benefactor of the College, we received some 140 volumes, including a number of interesting architectural works. Through the generosity of William G. Mather, Esquire, of the Class of 1877, a Trustee of the College, we received a set of Curtis's magnificent work on the North American Indian. The set includes twelve volumes of text, elaborately illustrated and bound, and twelve portfolios of plates. Altogether the work is one of the most elaborate and costly ever issued in America, and our Library may well take pride in possessing it. From Edgar F. Waterman, Esquire, Trustee and Treasurer of the College, we received a collection of Trinitiana, including bound volumes of the *Tablet*, the *Tripod*, and the *Ivy*. Eight volumes of the New England Historical and Genealogical Register, bringing our set up to date, six volumes of the Virginia Magazine of History and Biography, supplementing our file, and seven volumes of the New York Biographical and Genealogical Record were included.

From the offices of the President and the Treasurer, numerous items are received from time to time.

We are indebted again to the State Board of Education for the gift of eight bound volumes of Town reports.

We acknowledge again gratefully the gifts of their publications by the Carnegie Institution, the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, the Smithsonian Institution, the Government of the United States, and the State of Connecticut.



## CATALOGUING

The work of the year in this department, in addition to cataloguing current accessions, has been largely reclassifying and recataloguing. Altogether 2005 volumes not previously catalogued have been fully catalogued and shelved. 3012 volumes have been recatalogued and 2302 volumes reclassified. Substantial progress has been made in the work of revising our catalogue, but the end is by no means yet. The work of the year may be summarized:

That is to say, in addition to cataloguing over 31,000 volumes not before catalogued, the recataloguing of over 47,000 volumes has been completed. The importance of this to the users of the Library is too obvious to require comment.

## BINDING

The appropriation of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for binding has as usual been expended largely in binding current periodicals, though progress has been made in "catching up" with the binding of other material, much of which still sadly needs attention. It is earnestly hoped that this appropriation may be continued.

## FUNDS

We are still without income from the Canfield, the Northam, and the Sheffield Funds. These Funds are slowly being restored under the care of the Treasurer, but even when restored, our Funds for book purchase will be pitifully inadequate. It is imperative that the Funds for the purchase of books should be largely increased in the near future. The attention of friends of the College to this great need, and corresponding opportunity of helpfulness, is respectfully and earnestly commended.

## A RECOMMENDATION AND A REQUEST

The congestion on the top floor of the stack due to the growth of the collection of publications of the United States Government continues and is of course aggravated. Your Librarian ventures again to ask your honorable body for an appropriation to provide stacks for the remaining space on this floor. If stacks were provided here, the growth of the collection for a considerable number of years would be provided for. Relief here is imperatively needed.

## THE STAFF

Miss Louise M. Bailey, as Cataloguer, and Miss Laura Blinn, as assistant, have given efficient service. As has been remarked before, Miss Bailey is of service in innumerable ways, being in effect an Assistant Librarian.

The Student Assistants were Frank S. Jones, Harris H. Thomas, Herbert J. Goodrich, N. Ross Parke, and Charles F. Whiston. Mr. G. B. Reynolds Meade has also assisted in filing Government documents.

## THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE

Professor Carpenter of the Library Committee has been absent on leave during the year, and his advice and helpfulness have been missed. The Librarian has, however, always been able to turn to President Ogilby; he has always been received with sympathetic interest and has received valuable aid on every appeal.

## CONCLUSION

The year now closed has been another year of steady growth and of real progress. The Library has, with the aid of the liberal appropriation of the Trustees, been able to purchase the new books most insistently demanded, and the progress made in cataloguing is gratifying. Our greatest need continues to be additional Funds for the purchase of books. May we not hope that friends of the College will help?
