LIBRARIAN'S REPORT.

Trinity College,

Hartford, Connecticut.

To the Trustees of Trinity College:

In accordance with Section Three of Article Fifteen of the Statutes of the College, I submit herewith the report of the Librarian for the year ending June 30, 1929.

As in other years, the Library has been kept open fifty-four hours per week, and the usual statistics in regard to attendance are given:

These figures are slightly above the average for the five year period, but such small variations are to be expected, and are of no particular significance; no marked change may be expected so long as conditions and methods of teaching remain about as they are.

INCREASE OF THE LIBRARY

During the year, there have been added to the Library 1992 volumes and 4577 pamphlets. Of these 687 volumes were purchased; all the pamphlets and 1305 volumes were presented. Included in the purchases are 137 volumes of unbound periodicals and 24 volumes paid for by the Departments of Chemistry, Civil Engineering, Economics, German, Bacteriology, Philosophy, and Romance Languages. Of the volumes added to the Library, 1211 are bound and 781 unbound. It should be added that some twenty-five unbound volumes and most of the volumes of unbound periodicals have already been bound or will be bound during the summer.

Without the generous appropriation from the Morgan Fund, it would have been impossible to secure the books essential to the work of instruction. A considerable number of the volumes bought were purchased for the collection of books included in Professor Costello's "List of Books for a College Student's Reading", of which a second and improved edition was issued in the fall. This collection is shelved separately in the Reading Room, and is of interest and value to all who use the Library.

The increasing cost of books and periodicals makes it more and more difficult to meet the needs of our public. Additional Funds are much needed, especially, perhaps, for the securing of books and periodicals sorely needed by the Science Departments.

Work, 2 vols; Dictionary of American Biography, 2 vols; Fay, Origins of the World War, 2 vols; Odell, Annals of the New York Stage, 2 vols; Regional Survey of New York and Its Environs, 10 vols; Heaviside, Electromagnetic Theory, 3 vols; Langlais, La Vie en France au Moyen Age, 4 vols; Blaschke, Vorlesungen uber Differential-geometric, 3 vols; Cowdry, Special Cytology, 2 vols; Hac & Gabet, Travels in Tartary, 2 vols; Kittredge, Witchcraft in Old and New England; Thomson, Elements of Mathematical Theory; Fisher, James Bryce; and Aristotle, Works, tr. Beckwith, to Charles G. Woodward, '98, President Ogilby, Edgar F. Waterman, '98, Judge Buffington, '75, Professor Robert B. Riggs, and to Professors Babbitt, Barret, Bissonnette, Costello, Galpin, Hutt, Shepard, E. W. Spaulding, J. A. Spaulding, and other members of the Faculty for their constant remembrance of the Library. The following alumni gave copies of their own books: Stanton T. F. Fendell, '17, David H. Shelling, and Richardson Wright, '10. The following honorary graduates gave copies of their books: the Rev. Dr. William Douglas Mackenzie. General James G. Harbord, Dr. William Cameron Forbes, Dr. William Renwick Riddell, and Professor Charles Seymour. Mrs. Ansel G. Cook gave us some one-hundred and thirty-five volumes. The Yale University Press gave us several of their valuable publications, a much appreciated courtesy. The President of Weslevan University, at the suggestion of E. Kent Hubbard, Esquire, '92, gave us a photographic facsimile of the original manuscript of Einstein's "Zur Einheitlichen Feld-Theorie", for which we are very grateful.

We acknowledge again, gratefully, the gifts of their publications by the Carnegie Institution, the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, the Smithsonian Institution, the State of Connecticut, and the Government of the United States. We are indebted again to the Connecticut State Board of Education for eight bound volumes of Town reports.

CATALOGUING

The work of the year in the cataloguing department has been largely the cataloguing of recent accessions, though not a little time has been given to reclassifying and recataloguing; 1281

volumes not before catalogued have been catalogued and shelved. 84 volumes have been recatalogued, and 293 volumes have been reclassified. The Trinitiana collection has been rearranged and is being catalogued.

BINDING

As usual, the greater part of the appropriation for binding has been spent in binding current periodicals, including a considerable number of volumes purchased to fill gaps in our sets. However, we have been able to bind some other material. Slowly we are catching up in this highly important work. It is requested that the appropriation be continued.

FUNDS

Your Librarian must again call attention to the great need of new Library Funds. A minimum of \$100,000 additional is needed to enable us to maintain our relative rank among New England college libraries; probably \$200,000 is nearer the mark. With the aid of the appropriation from the Morgan Fund, the continuation, and if possible the increase, of which is requested, we are able to purchase the books and periodicals most insistently demanded in the work of teaching, though with increasing costs,

even that is hardly possible. We are unable to subscribe for many periodicals much needed; much less are we able to buy complete files of them. The prices of these sets of periodicals are constantly rising, and they are becoming increasingly difficult to secure. This is especially true of scientific periodicals, in which we are perhaps weakest. Consequently, any plan for the systematic building up of our collection in any field is out of the question. In a word, we are living from hand to mouth. Surely at no very distant date some generous friend of the College will meet this great need.

STAFF

Miss Louise M. Bailey, as cataloguer, and Mrs. Harold Schatz, as Assistant, have given faithful and efficient service. The Student Assistants have been: George Anderson Hey,

Philip Henry Close, Jr., George Laurence Blauvelt, Joseph Delphis Gauthier, Charles Edward Jacobson, Robert Otto Muller, Gregory Jerome Wyckoff, Earl Greely Hunter, and Herbert George Norman. They are to be commended for their faithful service.

THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE

The resident members of the Library Committee, President Ogilby and Professor Costello, have been most interested and most helpful. Professor Costello's work on his book-list has given him a wide familiarity with the important literature in many fields; his advice is frequently sought and is always gladly given. It is unfortunate that it is impossible for the whole Committee to meet more frequently, for such meetings are always valuable and fruitful in helpful suggestions.

CONCLUSION


