NOTE.—In looking over this year's Index and comparing its results with those of last year, we are struck with two or three prominent facts, interesting to all those who read THE TABLET. First, the number of accepted and printed stories this year is about one-third more numerous, exceeding last year's record by nine. Secondly, the pages devoted to "Personals" and "College and Campus," forming as they do, the columns of greatest importance and interest to the Alumni, have been increased from thirty-four to sixty two—almost twice their former number; and thirdly, we have had to use in the three hundred or more pages of matter only four pages of clippings from exchanges, two-thirds less than what was used last year. All these prove conclusively, that at least the willingness to contribute to THE TABLET has increased, and that in the literary life of the College a stirring re-animation is felt, gratifying to all who have the honor of our Alma Mater at heart, in this branch of College activity.
